

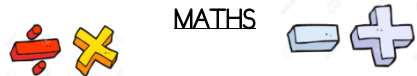
Year 6

MATHS

This term we will be focussing on;

Pop Art Study! We will be exploring this fun style of art including a visit to Wolverhampton Art gallery and studying the amazing artist Andy Warhol.

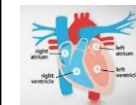
PE

- Black shoes- no trainers,

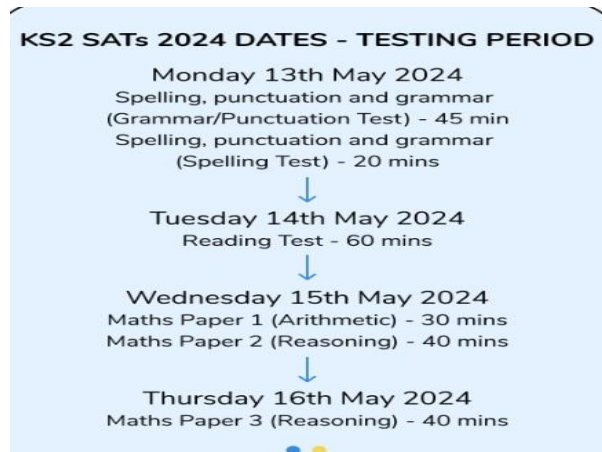
Summer term in Y6!
