Sports ambassadors introduced the week to the whole school in an assembly.



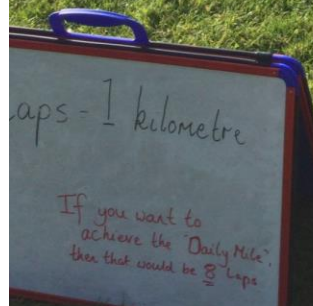

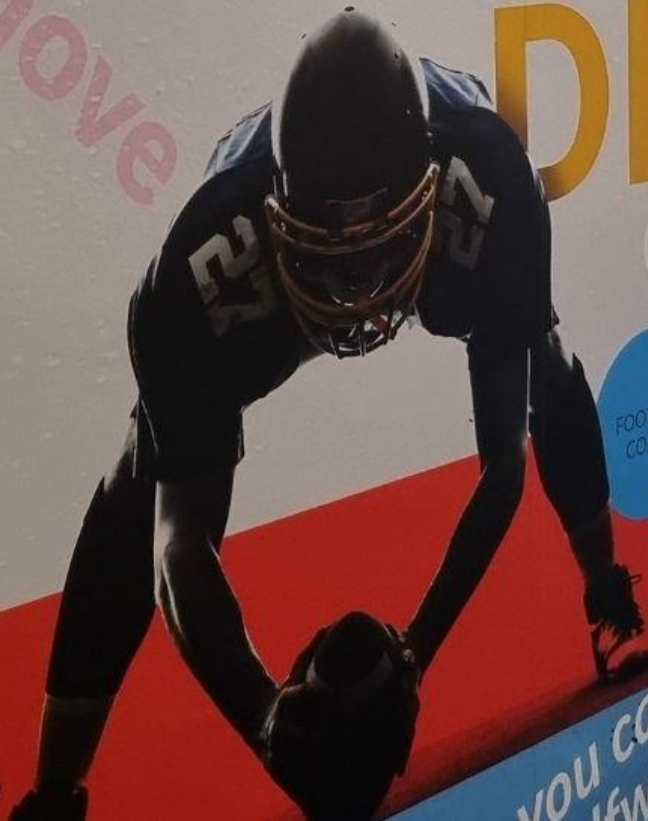

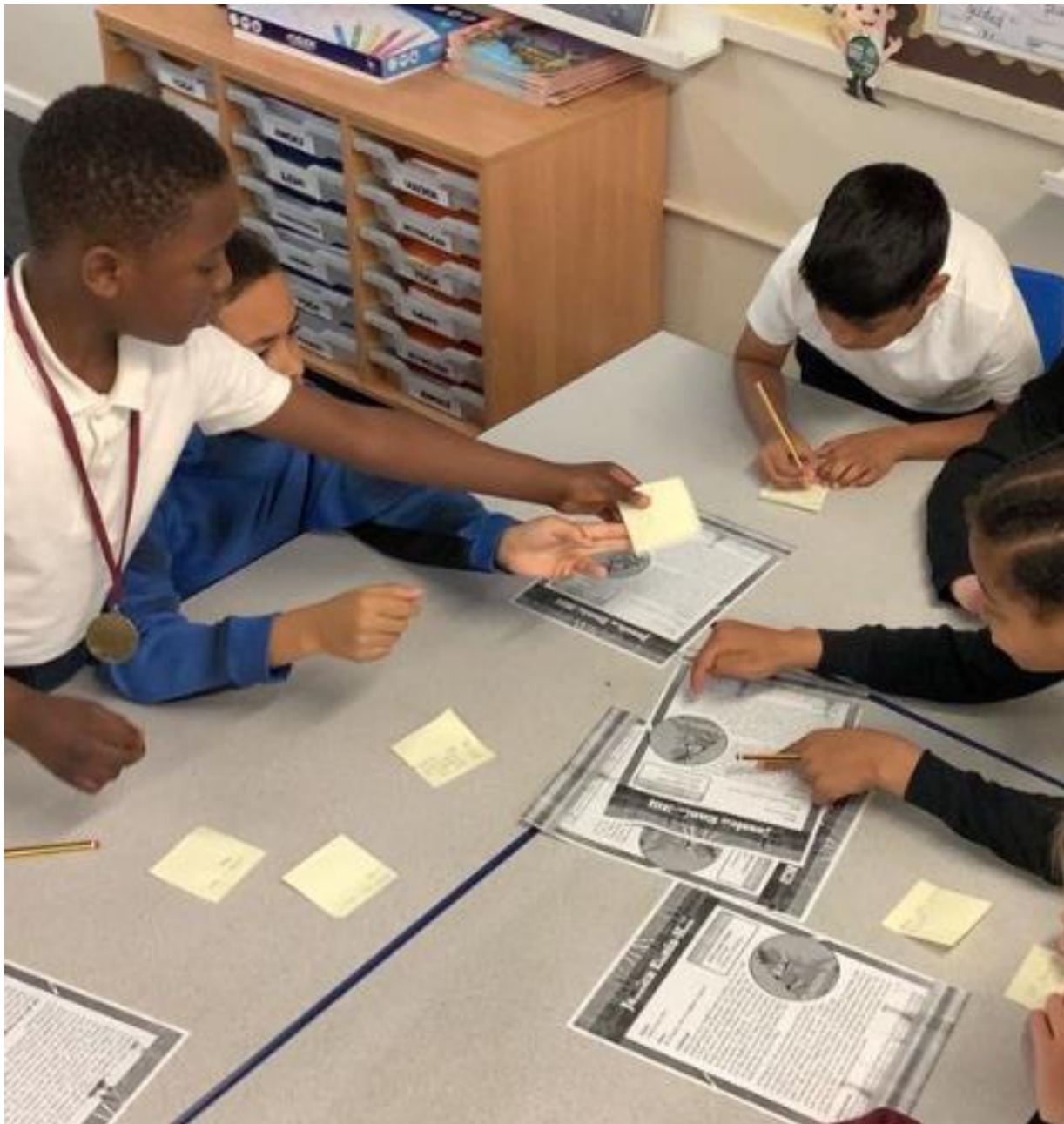

# Maths during Sports Week

Final Olympic Turns

Jump in air  
 amount of people in the crowd  
 clockwise turn  
 360° turn

Height of person in relay  
 Run in relay  
 acute angle between legs  
 90° angle (right angle)  
 270° turn  
 Lines of water in pool  
 acute angle  
 More than 90° / less than 180°  
 I think it is 130°  
 90° angle (right angle)  
 circumference of the ball

Final Olympic Turns

In between the legs there is a 90° angle  
 They are in order  
 In between the arms the angle is 90°

In between a person's thigh and leg it is a slightly larger 90°  
 The body on the person's back should be a right angle

She is doing a 180° turn and because she is doing a 180° her legs are a 180°

The lines on the track are 90°  
 The number plate is a square on the hurdles is a 90°

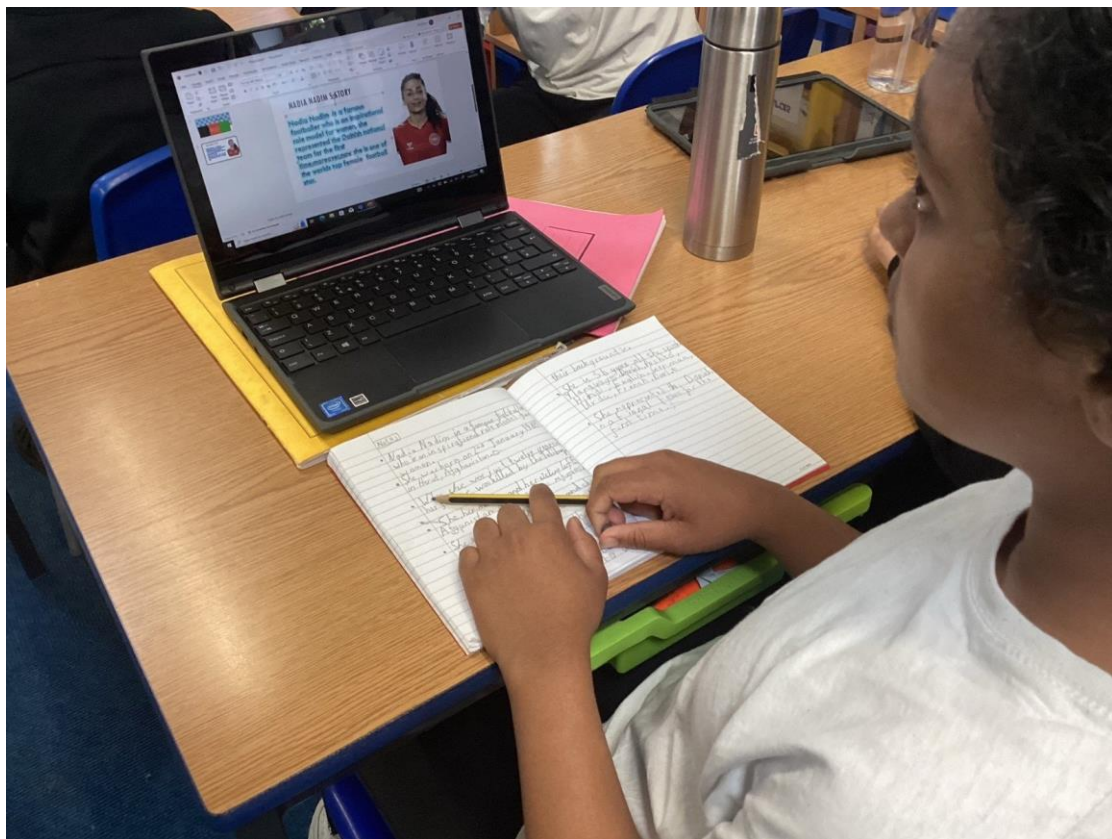

 Because when they are jumping and those legs are straight this is a reflex angle more (or ready) 180 but less than 360.

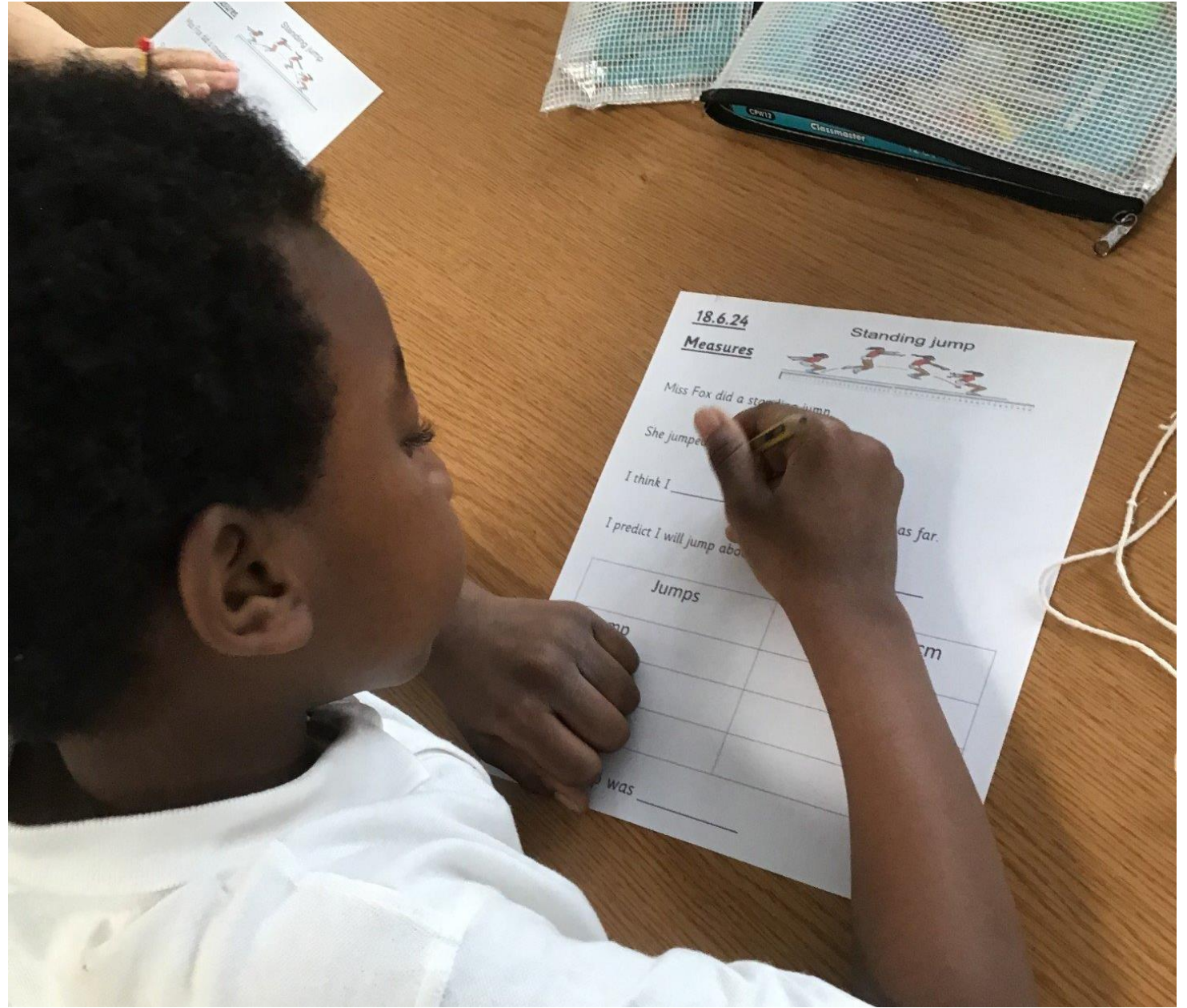
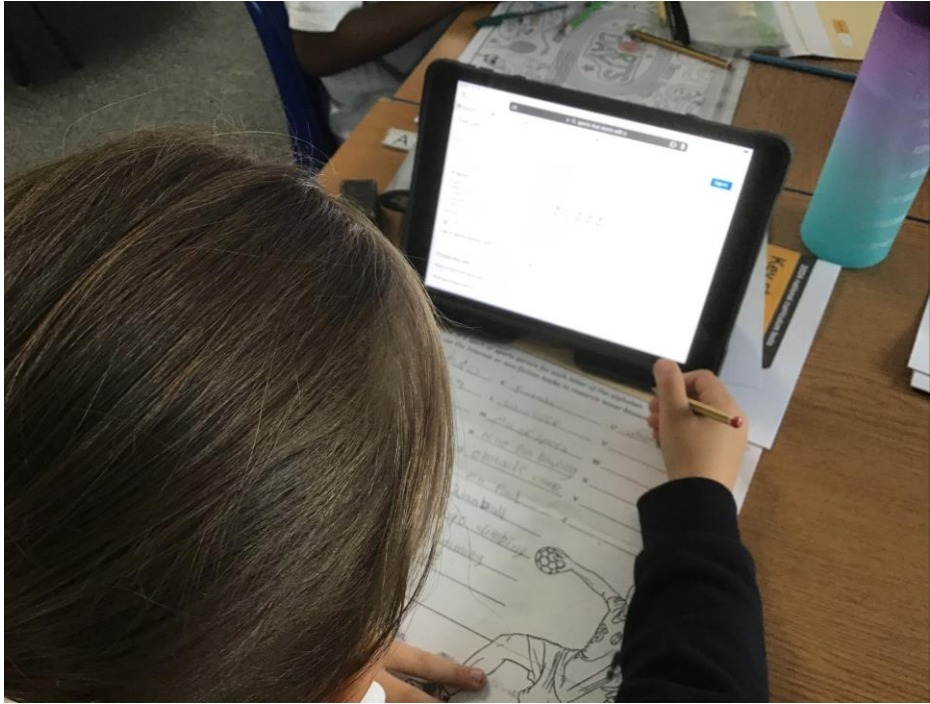
Swimming
